Airmen Recruitment Rally to be held at Itanagar

The Indian Air Force is going to conduct Recruitment Rally at Dera Natung Government College, Itanagar Capital Complex, Arunachal Pradesh, exclusively for eligible unmarried male candidates of the state to join as Airmen in Group X (Technical) and Group Y(Non Technical) trades. The Rally is scheduled to be held from 26th Sep to 28th September 2015. The requisite qualification for Group X(Technical) Trades is passed Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent Examination with Mathematics, Physics and English with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English or Passed three years Diploma Course in Engineering(Mechanical/ Electrical/ Electronics/ Automobile/ Computer Science/ Instrumentation Technology/ Information Technology) from a Government recognized Polytechnic Institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English and for Group Y the requisite qualification is passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent Examination in any stream/ subjects approved by Central/ State Education Boards with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English or passed two years Vocational Course affiliated/ recognized by CBSE/ State Education Boards/ Councils duly recognized at par with 10+2 by Association of Indian Universities(AIU) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course.

The candidates have to initially take a written test and adaptability test at the time of application. Those passing the written and adaptability test will undergo a physical fitness test followed by interview after which they have to appear for medical examination at the Air Force Medical Examination Centre. The process of recruitment of Airmen is through All India Selection Tests and Recruitment Rallies. Presently, 11 Airmen Selection Centre are responsible for conducting Recruitment Rally of Airmen in the Indian Air Force from North East region. In Arunachal Pradesh, the Centre has already conducted four(4) rallies since 2010 and a total of 222 candidates have been enrolled so far out of the total 1458 appeared.

The duty of an Airmen in the Indian Air Force is to make sure that all the air and ground operations run smoothly. From operation Air Defence Systems to fitting missiles, they are involved in all activities of an air base and give support to various technical and non- technical posts. The airmen of technical trades are responsible for maintenance, repair and prepare of use of the propulsion system of aircraft and other airborne weapon delivery system etc whereas the airmen of non- technical trades are responsible for organization administrations, accounts and environment safety systems.

One of the perks of joining the airmen is that besides providing employment opportunity it provides various other facilities like free mess, clothing, medical service, sport, transport, library, gym and adventure activities and career enhancement opportunities in various fields.

The Indian Air Force was officially established on 8th October 1932 and with the passage of time, it has undertaken massive upgrading of its aircraft and various equipments and as part of the process it has introduced a wide variety of modern equipments, weapon systems, communication and detection systems.

This Recruitment Rally is being organized has been possible due to the active cooperation of the Capital Administration in order to facilitate conduct of such Rallies within the Capital Complex to enable the prospective candidates to participate in large numbers. Whenever such recruitments are conducted outside the State, many local prospective candidates find it difficult to participate due to various reasons. Since , it is being held for the benefits of local candidates of the State, the Deputy Commissioner Itanagar Capital Complex Mr. Mige Kamki has appealed all the interested candidates who have passed class XII to participate and take maximum advantage of the Recruitment Rally so that the eligible candidates can be employed in the IAF.

We acknowledge active cooperation of VPV Baliga Squadron Leader Borjhar Guwahati who has shown active interest to conduct this Recruitment Rally consecutively for the second time in the Itanagar Capital Complex. We are expecting participation of senior Air Force Officers of the region and put up interesting programs as a part of the Recruitment Rally. Stressing that such an endeavor on the part of the Indian Air Force would provide the unemployed youths of the state with an opportunity to serve the nation with pride and glory. During the 2014 Recruitment Rally conducted in Itanagar only 99 candidates participated out of which at least 20 candidates were selected which were recorded as one of the highest recruitment rate of selection. This time, we invite our eligible youths to participate in the Rally.
