NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 31st August, 2010

S.O. 2172(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 8 of the Census Act, 1948 (37 of 1948), the Central Government hereby instructs and directs that the Census Officer may ask all such questions of all persons within the limits of the local area for which he is appointed, for collecting information through the Household Schedule in connection with the Census of India 2011, on the items enumerated below, namely :

11. Other languages known
12. Literacy status
13. Status of attendance in educational institution
14. Highest educational level attained
15. Characteristics of workers and non-workers —Worked any time during last year (for main, marginal and non-workers)
16. Category of economic activity
17. Occupation
18. Nature of industry, trade or service
19. Class of worker
20. Non-economic activity (for marginal and non-worker)

22. Travel to place of work
23. Migration characteristics—Birth place

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED TRIBES) ORDER
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 2008

No. 14 OF 2008

[1st April, 2008]

An Act further to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Orders, 1950 to modify the list of Scheduled Tribe in the State of Arunachal Pradesh.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the fifty-ninth year of the Republic of India as follows:-
